DIODES ANNOUNCES MANAGEMENT CHANGE

--- Strengthens Relationship with Vishay/Lite-On ---

Westlake Village, California — May 28, 1998 — Diodes Incorporated (Amex: DIO) today announced that Joseph Liu has been named the President of Vishay/Lite-On Power Semiconductor Pte., LTD. (“Vishay/LPSC”), further strengthening the Company’s relationship with its strategic alliance.

In addition to his responsibilities at Vishay/LPSC, Mr. Liu will remain President of Shanghai KaiHong Electronics Co., Ltd. (“KaiHong”), the Company’s manufacturing joint venture in China, as well as the Company’s Vice President, Far East Operations.

Michael Rosenberg, the Company’s President noted, “We are most appreciative of Mr. Liu’s outstanding contributions over the past nine years as the principal catalyst in the Company’s growth and recent efforts to expand its manufacturing capacity. We are pleased that Mr. Liu will continue to manage the Company’s manufacturing facilities at KaiHong and Diodes-Taiwan and that we will continue to have access to his extensive experience in manufacturing and operations of the Company.”

Carl Wertz, the Company’s Controller since 1993, has been appointed to replace Mr. Liu as the Company’s Chief Financial Officer. Before joining the Company, Mr. Wertz served in various financial and accounting positions, most recently as Controller of Westco Products, a \$180 million manufacturer and distributor of food products, headquartered in Pico Rivera, California. Mr. Wertz, a licensed CPA, began his accounting career with Deloitte & Touche LLP.

“We are very fortunate to have such a capable financial officer experienced in the Company’s operations to succeed Mr. Liu,” continued Mr. Rosenberg, “and we look forward to Mr. Wertz’s continued contributions to the Company.”

Vishay/LPSC, the Company's largest shareholder of approximately 41%, is also a major supplier of the Company's products, supplying approximately 32% in 1997. Vishay/LPSC is a joint venture between Vishay Intertechnology, Inc. ("Vishay") and the Lite-On Group. Vishay (NYSE: VSH), a *Fortune 1000* company and the largest manufacturer of passive electronic components in the United States and Europe, entered the active component market through the formation of Vishay/LPSC in 1997. The Lite-On Group, is a Taiwanese consortium and leading manufacturer of computer peripherals and communication products.

Diodes Incorporated provides high-quality discrete semiconductor devices and customer support to leading manufacturers in the automotive, electronics, computing and telecommunications industries. Diodes' products include small signal transistors and MOSFETs, transient voltage suppressors (TVSs), zeners, Schottkys, diodes, rectifiers and bridges.
